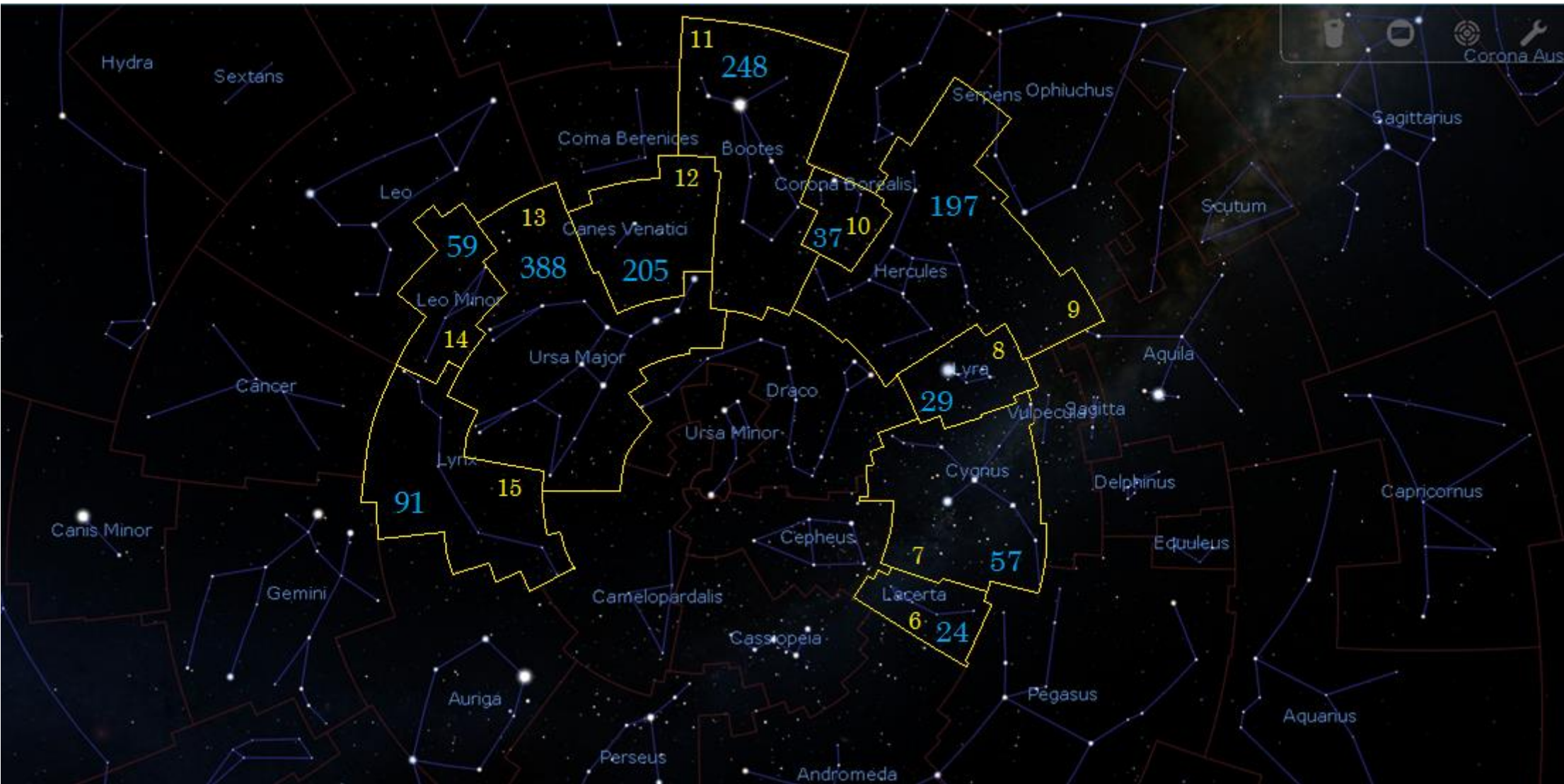


The Distribution of NGC Objects Across the Constellations

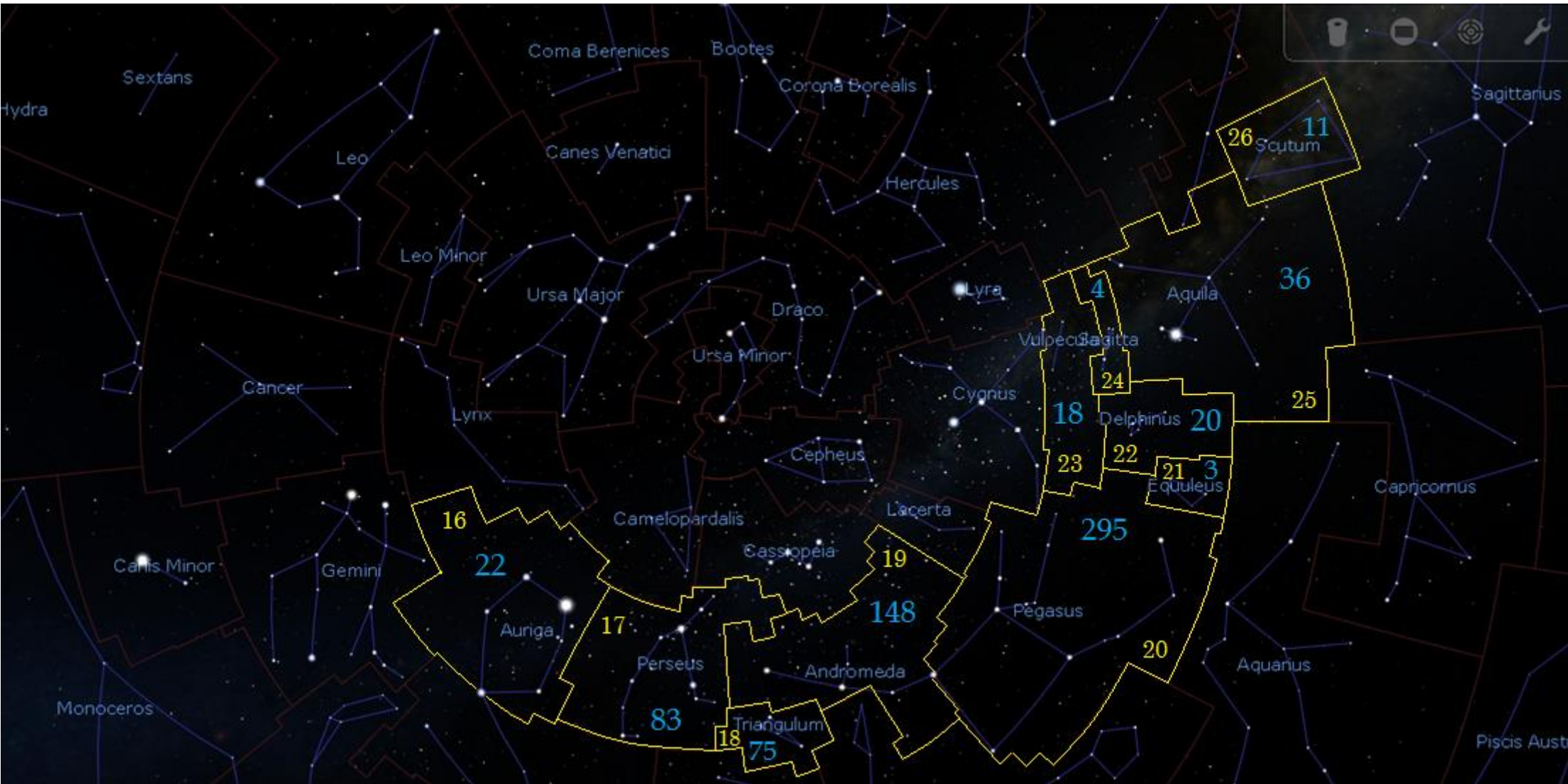

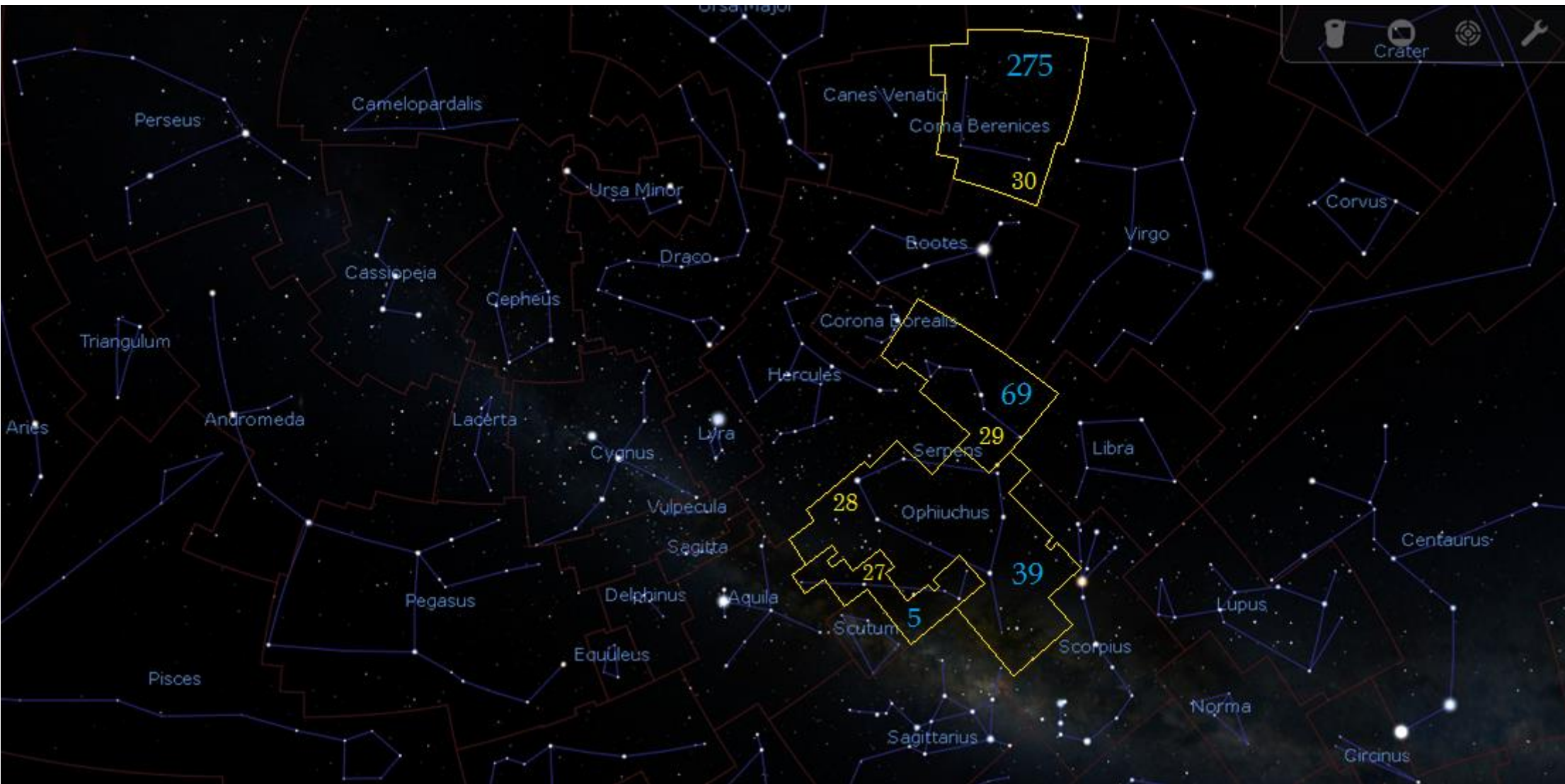

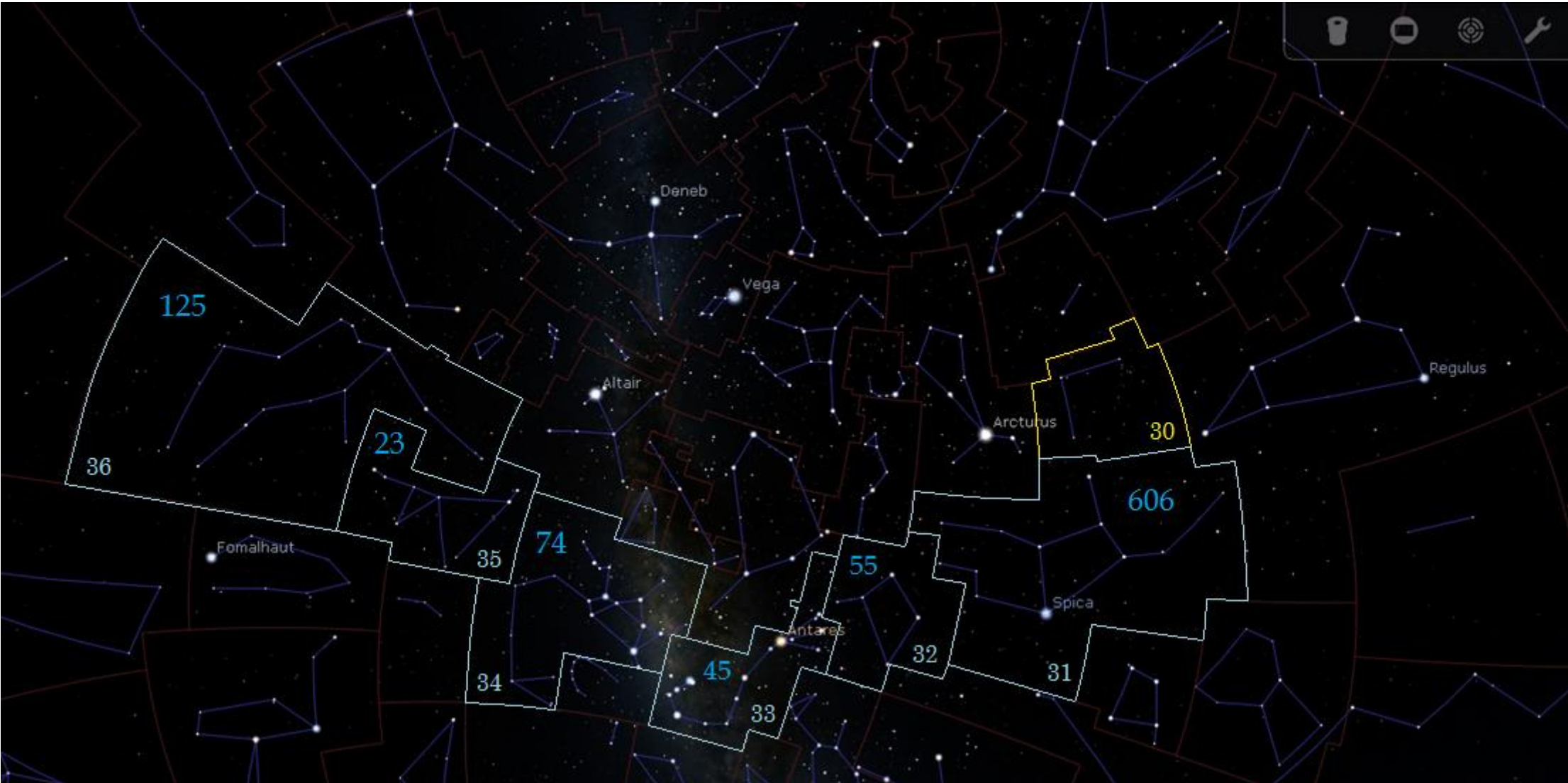

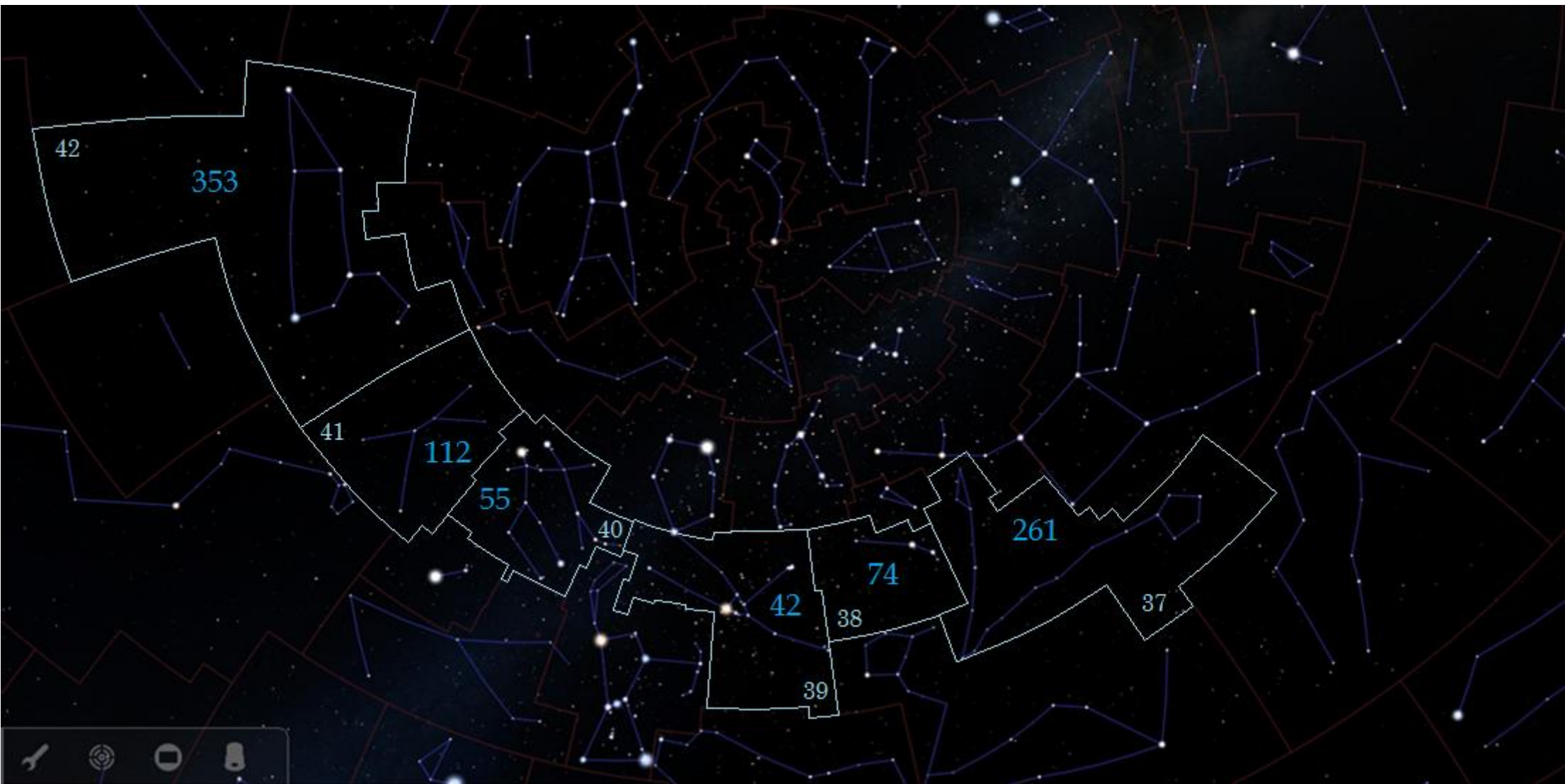

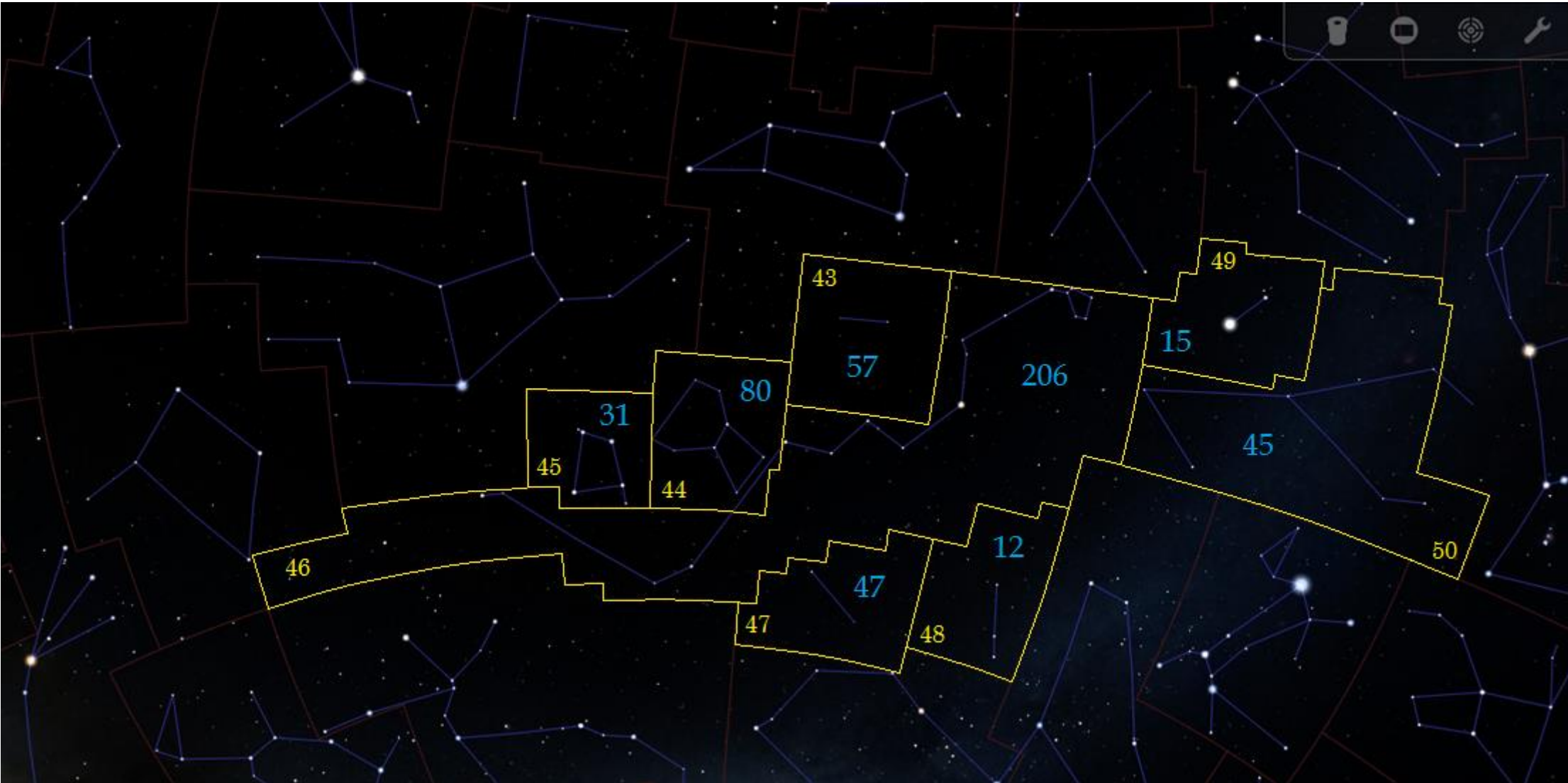
